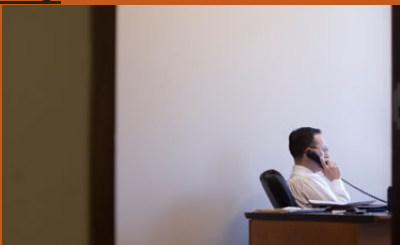

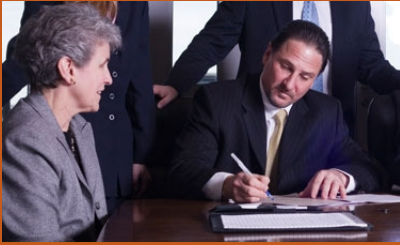
Misericordia hosted economic forum for business leaders series
